NFL Club Constitution (2022-2023)

ARTICLE I. NAME OF STUDENT ORGANIZATION

The organization shall be called NFL Club.

ARTICLE II. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The purpose of this social student org is to bring together students who have an interest in watching and talking about NFL football. The goal is to create a group environment where anyone can join in on the fun and have a good time watching football together.

ARTICLE III. NONPROFIT STATEMENT

NFL Club is a non-profit student organization.

ARTICLE IV. REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP

There are no dues or fees needed to join the organization or to join the NFL Club Discord. Any UCSD student is welcome to join the club. No prior knowledge about football or its fandom is needed to join the organization. Note that membership in a Registered Student Organization shall be open to any student, consistent with the Nondiscrimination Policy Statement for University of California Publications regarding Student-Related Matters, with the exception that membership in an officially recognized sorority or fraternity may be limited by gender. (UCOP Policy on Registered Campus Organizations, Section 70.10).

ARTICLE V. FREQUENCY OF ORGANIZATION MEETINGS

There will be no limit on the number of "meetings" from the NFL Club. This is a social student org where the members are free to chat and discuss availability to meet and watch or talk about football at any time. The gathering of members may be on or off campus. These decisions can be openly discussed or changed by members at any point in time.

ARTICLE VI. QUALIFICATIONS FOR HOLDING OFFICE AND METHODS OF SELECTING AND REPLACING OFFICERS*

Only registered UC San Diego students may hold office in the organization. Only registered UC San Diego students may vote in elections for the selection of the organization's officers.

Due to the social nature of this student organization, there will be no need to elect officer positions. The principal members shall be the ones who interact with the university resources for

any needs that the organization may come across such as scheduling events. Everyone else involved in the organization will have the title of "Member".

ARTICLE VII. RISK MANAGEMENT

NFL Club is a registered student organization at the University of California, San Diego, but not part of the University itself.

NFL Club understands that the University does not assume legal liability for the actions of the organization.

There should be no inherent risks associated with the NFL Club as its activities include messaging in the Club's discord, watching televised football games, and discussing the happenings of those games.
