

Constitution of
Korea Campus Crusade for Christ (K.C.C.C)

- **Article I: Name of Student Organization**
 - The organization shall be called Korea Campus Crusade for Christ or KCCC at UC San Diego

- **Article II: Statement of Purpose**
 - The purpose of Korea Campus Crusade for Christ is to help fulfill the Great Commission at UC San Diego by training students to live out a Christian life after College through bible study groups, prayer meetings, worship sessions, and fellowship. Korea Campus Crusade for Christ is a non-profit, non-denominational Christian organization.

- **Article III: Nonprofit Statement**
 - Korea Campus Crusade for Christ at UC San Diego is a non-profit student organization

- **Article IV: Requirements for Memberships**
 - There are no requirements to be a member of Korea Campus Crusade for Christ. There is no membership fee and any student, faculty, or staff is free to join and participate in K.C.C.C. activities.

- **Article V: Frequency of the organization's meetings**
 - There will be two meetings a week. On Tuesdays at 7 pm we will have a large group meeting. There we will have a short message and fellowship. On Mondays there will be a small group leaders meeting (SJ training) at 7 pm. The times and places for these meetings may change throughout the year depending on room availability.

- **Article VI: Qualification for holding office and methods of selecting officers**
 - Any student who has been in Korea Campus Crusade for Christ for over one year and has completed the required training is eligible to serve as a small group bible study leader and thus can also be qualified to serve on office/student council. However, the decision of selecting and replacing officers will ultimately be handled by K.C.C.C.'s community advisor (KCCC fulltime ministry staff). The community advisor will appoint one student body president, one vice president, one historian/treasurer, one secretary (chongmoo), and two bangjangs (house leaders).
 - Only registered UC San Diego students may hold office in the organization. Only registered UC San Diego students may vote in elections for the selection of the organization's officers.

Article VII: Risk Management

- Korea Campus Crusade for Christ at UC San Diego is a registered student organization at University of California, San Diego, but not part of the University itself.
- Korea Campus Crusade for Christ at UC San Diego understands that the University does not assume legal liability for the actions of the organization.

Section 1:

- Korea Campus Crusade for Christ does not work with minors or elderly.

Section 2:

- Korea Campus Crusade for Christ will not be involved with providing medical assistance.

Section 3:

- Korea Campus Crusade for Christ will not be engaged in international travel.

Section 4:

- Korea Campus Crusade for Christ will not handle any hazardous chemicals, materials, equipment, or machinery.

• **Article VIII: Community Advisor**

- Korea Campus Crusade for Christ in the Southern California Region appoint fulltime staff as community advisors. The advisors have an official training process and serve throughout the campuses of Southern California. In UC San Diego, we have three community advisors: David Yoontae Oh, Bora Kim, and Eugene Kim.
- They generally serve 3~4 years on a campus until campus rotations where staff switch around to be community advisors for different campuses.
- Their role as community advisors is to communicate with the leaders and student representatives about training leaders and leading events throughout the week.

• **Article IX: Financial Management**

- In terms of financing our activities, we have a ministry fund bank account that is set up through our student representative, mainly treasurer. We have fundraisers/donations from our leaders that help us support our events throughout the year.
- The finances are handled by the treasurer in distribution and collection through a bank account.
- Korea Campus Crusade for Christ will not submit a budget to the A.S. or G.S.A. finance committee quarterly.

• **Article X: Affiliation with Other Groups**

- Korea Campus Crusade for Christ is affiliated with Cru on an international level. This ministry itself is spread on campuses internationally and have affiliations with each other as well.

- This affiliation means that we may have joint events or possibly help/support each other. It does not have direct correlations for any of the members of Korea Campus Crusade for Christ.
- These affiliations do not come with any additional requirements for the organization or its members.
