

Article I. Name of Student Organization*

The organization shall be called [Kristos Campus Missions (KCM)] at UC San Diego.

Article II. Statement of Purpose*

KCM exists to care for collegians by discipling them to value the glory of God through local and global missions, ultimately to benefit and build up the local church of Jesus Christ.

Article III. Nonprofit Statement*

[Kristos Campus Missions (KCM)] at UC San Diego is a non-profit student organization.

Article IV. Requirements for Membership*

All UC San Diego students are welcome to join KCM. There are no dues or fees required for membership. It is by the discretion of the KCM core leadership team and greater KCM staff that members will be considered for disqualification of membership should there be a notable reason.

Article V. Frequency of Organization Meetings*

KCM holds weekly meetings on campus. Tuesday Night Prayer, Tuesday Outreach EVs, and Thursday General Meetings occur weekly, while other events such as Outreach Game Nights or Wednesday Morning Prayer occur occasionally throughout the year.

Article VI. Qualifications for Holding Office and Methods of Selecting and Replacing Officers*

Only registered UC San Diego students may hold office in the organization. Only registered UC San Diego students may vote in elections for the selection of the organization's officers.

There are 9 officers that each lead a ministry of servant team leaders (except the President): President, Inreach, Outreach, Praise, Prayer, Missions, Small Group (male and female), and Visual Arts and Media (VAM). Inreach organizes social functions, Outreach organizes community service events, Praise leads worship, Prayer leads prayer meetings, Small Group organizes freshmen into small groups, and VAM manages the media and online projects for KCM. Officers (aka "Cores") are nominated by both the previous officer team and by the incoming President in Spring Quarter and once the offer is accepted, they serve the following academic year. Officers are considered for demotion if 3 separate individuals complain about this officer's conduct or character. The final decision is made based on majority vote (excluding the individual) and the President's final discernment. Should the officer position become vacant, a new officer candidate may be appointed or the responsibilities will be shared amongst the remaining officers.

Freshmen accountability leaders also exist to help facilitate freshmen-based events. This is an opportunity for freshmen to step up and have leadership roles. They must apply through a formal application process and are finalized based on the officers' discretion.

All ministry members, or servant team leaders, are required to apply through a formal application and interview process. The results of these applicants will be based on the officers/cores' thorough discussion and discretion, with guidance from the greater KCM staff.

Article VII. Risk Management*

[Kristos Campus Missions (KCM)] at UC San Diego is a registered student organization at University of California, San Diego, but not part of the University itself.

[Kristos Campus Missions (KCM)] at UC San Diego understands that the University does not assume legal liability for the actions of the organization.

As KCM is a mission-based organization, there will be opportunities for student members to apply and serve in international mission trips over the summer. However, students are made aware of any foreseeable risks and the overall commitment of traveling to the mission fields, so it is the student's responsibility to decide whether or not to partake in these opportunities as they are optional.

Article VII. Section 3. In Case of International Travel

[Kristos Campus Missions] at UC San Diego recognizes that the University generally recommends against all international travel by Student Organizations due to the myriad of risks travelers face in foreign countries. Student organizations are discouraged from traveling to foreign countries due to the wide variety of risks involved with foreign travel, and the extensive planning efforts required by the Student Organization's Members to manage those risks. Security risks and health care services vary widely from one country to another, so thorough research on those topics is especially important.

International travelers are advised to research US State Department Travel Advisories and the CDC Travel Health site and abide by all recommended alerts and warnings, and procure travel insurance with medical coverage that covers their chosen destination because most USA Health Plans are not valid in foreign countries.

Article IX. Financial Management

The Officer/Core team will manage the organization's finances. Detailed spreadsheets are kept for accountability. Funds are typically raised and used for the general body. Our student organization will submit a budget to the A.S. for financial support.

Article X. Affiliation with Other Groups

[Kristos Campus Missions] at UC San Diego will be affiliated with other KCM chapters across Southern California. This doesn't change any requirements for the members or officers.
