Korean Hope Church AT UC SAN DIEGO CONSTITUTION - 2023-2024 ACADEMIC YEAR

ARTICLE I. NAME OF ORGANIZATION

The organization shall be called Korean Hope Church at UC San Diego.

ARTICLE II. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

To ensure that UCSD students, both undergraduate and graduate, can gather and have fellowship in the name of Jesus, and grow in God so that they may be able to positively impact the society during and after college.

ARTICLE III. NONPROFIT STATEMENT

Korean Hope Church at UC San Diego is a non-profit student organization.

ARTICLE IV. REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP

There is no requirement in order to be a member of Korean Hope Church. There is no membership fee and any student, faculty, or staff is free to join and participate in KOREAN HOPE CHURCH activities.

ARTICLE V. FREQUENCY OF ORGANIZATION MEETINGS

There will be three meetings a week. On Thursdays at 8 pm we will have a large group meeting. There we will have a short message and fellowship. On Tuesdays there will be a small group meeting at 7 pm, every other week. On Fridays there will be prayer meetings at 8 p.m. The times and places for these meetings may change throughout the year depending on room availability.

ARTICLE VI. QUALIFICATIONS FOR HOLDING OFFICE AND METHODS OF SELECTING AND REPLACING OFFICERS

Only registered UC San Diego students may hold office in the organization. Only registered UC San Diego students may vote in elections for the selection of the organization's officers.

Any student who has been in Korean Hope Church for over one year and has

completed the required training is eligible to serve as a small group bible study leader and thus can also be qualified to serve on office/student council. However, the decision of selecting and replacing officers will ultimately be handled by Korean Hope Church community advisor. The community advisor will appoint one student body president, one vice president, one treasurer, one secretary, and three group leaders.

ARTICLE VII. RISK MANAGEMENT

Korean Hope Church at UC San Diego is a registered student organization at the University of California, San Diego, but not part of the University itself.

Korean Hope Church at UC San Diego understands that the University does not assume legal liability for the actions of the organization.
