

## CHESS CLUB CONSTITUTION

1. Name of Organization: Chess Club at UC San Diego
2. Statement of Purpose:

To promote an intellectually challenging and fun environment through the sport of chess with weekly friendly contests and occasional tournaments to UC San Diego
3. Chess Club at UC San Diego is a non-profit organization.
4. Requirements

We welcome players and students of all levels as long as they desire to learn about chess.
5. Frequency of the organization meetings

Will meet every Friday from 15:00 to 18:00 @Geisel Library Chess Board
6. Qualifications for holding office and methods selecting and replacing officers:
  - a. Only registered UCSD students may hold office in the organization.
  - b. Only registered UCSD students may vote in elections for the selection of the organization's officers.
  - c. President- Will approve of all the activities the club will undertake. Will head the meetings and will be in charge of starting the meeting.
  - d. Co-President- Whenever the president is absent will take over his duties. He will also aid the president with managing and coordinating events.
  - e. Treasurer- Will handle all monetary expenditures, including fundraising and tournament-related expenses. Will give a list of current money and expenditures at the beginning of each tournament meeting.
  - f. Event Manager- Will be in charge of the tournament. Will come up with a date and time. Also will create the system for the tournament. Will bring up at the meeting and get approval of President, Co-President and at least half the members. If need be, a Event Manager can be appointed to assist with advertising.
  - g. Board Members- The entry position to start learning about the board's organization, they participate in board meetings through giving and commenting on ideas with voting rights.
  - h. Election of officers (if need be) will be during 1st meeting, will hold office for two weeks where the full time officers will be selected on 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting.
  - i. Officers will be in office through the whole quarter and will be reelected at the beginning of the first meeting of the next quarter.
  - j. To remove an officer, a member must provide a good reason and more than half the members must vote for the removal. For any office beside the president, the member who provided the reason will take over that office until the next meeting where a replacement officer will be selected.

7. Risk Management:
  - a. Chess is a board game and this club does not foresee any violent or hazardous activities associated with normal play.
8. Chess Club at UC San Diego is a registered student organization at University of California, San Diego, but not part of the University itself.
