

CAMPUS ADVENTIST NETWORK AT UC SAN DIEGO CONSTITUTION: 2024-2025 ACADEMIC YEAR

ARTICLE I. NAME OF ORGANIZATION

The organization shall be called Campus Adventist Network (CAN) at UC San Diego.

ARTICLE II. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

Campus Adventist Network (CAN) aims to foster a community of Seventh-Day Adventists (SDA) and share the word of the SDA church with UCSD students through weekly Bible studies and fellowship. The SDA church is unique from other Christian denominations because we believe in the Sabbath Day, which honors every seventh day (Saturday) as a holy day to rest and worship God.

ARTICLE III. NONPROFIT STATEMENT

Campus Adventist Network at UC San Diego is a non-profit student organization.

ARTICLE IV. REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP

Open to any members who are willing to learn about the mission of the Seventh Day Adventist Church. There are no fees required for membership, and there are no restrictions. One becomes a member by frequently attending meetings.

ARTICLE V. FREQUENCY OF ORGANIZATION MEETINGS

We will hold meetings on a weekly basis. There are no required meetings, and minutes will not be recorded.

ARTICLE VI. QUALIFICATIONS FOR HOLDING OFFICE AND METHODS OF SELECTING AND REPLACING OFFICERS

Only registered UC San Diego students may hold office in the organization. Only registered UC San Diego students may vote in elections for the selection of the organization's officers. We will have three officer positions for President, Vice President, and Secretary that will be elected by the officers from the previous year. The term of office will last for one school year (Fall - Spring)

Campus Adventist Network at UC San Diego is a registered student organization at the University of California, San Diego, but not part of the University itself.
