

Reformed University Fellowship International at UC San Diego Constitution 2024-2025 Academic Year

Article I. Name of Organization

Section 1. The name of this organization shall be Reformed University Fellowship International at UC San Diego.

Article II. Purpose

Section 1. The purpose of Reformed University Fellowship International at UC San Diego is to glorify God by believing, living, and proclaiming the good news of Jesus Christ in word and deed among the international community at UC San Diego. We seek to accomplish this in three key ways: (1) welcome and show hospitality to students and scholars from all nations; (2) explore the gospel of Jesus Christ with interested students and scholars; and (3) equip those students and scholars who want to honor and enjoy God in every area of life.

Article III. Nonprofit Statement

Section 1. Reformed University Fellowship International at UC San Diego is a non-profit student organization.

Article IV. Membership

Section 1. Membership shall be limited to UC San Diego students, visiting scholars, faculty and staff.

Section 2. No dues or fees are a prerequisite for members.

ARTICLE V. Government

Section 1. Only registered UC San Diego students may hold office in the organization. Only registered UC San Diego students may vote in elections for the selection of the organization's officers.

Section 2. The only official positions are those of the principal members. Such a position grants the holders no privileges other than those granted to them by the university. Such privileges include but are not limited to reserving rooms and requesting

funding from the university on behalf of Reformed University Fellowship International at UC San Diego.

Section 3. Principal members must be currently registered UC San Diego students who are in good standing with the university and who agree with and support the purpose of the organization as stated in Article II.

Article VI. Risk Management

Section 1. Reformed University Fellowship International at UC San Diego is a registered student organization at the University of California, San Diego, but not part of the University itself.

Section 2. Reformed University Fellowship International at UC San Diego understands that the University does not assume legal liability for the actions of the organization.

Article VII. Affiliation with Reformed University Fellowship

Section 1. Reformed University Fellowship International at UC San Diego is affiliated with Reformed University Ministries (hereafter referred to as RUM), a campus ministry of the Presbyterian Church in America (hereafter referred to as PCA).

Section 2. Reformed University Fellowship International at UC San Diego will receive guidance from a Campus Minister of the South Coast Presbytery of the PCA, and therefore, will operate as an officially sanctioned campus chapter of RUM.

Section 3: There are no requirements for members to be part of or associated with RUM or the PCA.
