ARTICLE I. NAME OF STUDENT ORGANIZATION

The organization shall be called Boardgames and Boba at UC San Diego.

ARTICLE II. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

To establish a welcoming campus organization dedicated to fostering a vibrant community of card game and board game enthusiasts. Our primary goal is to unite students through enjoyable gaming experiences while enhancing the social atmosphere by offering refreshing boba tea to all members, creating a relaxed and inclusive environment.

ARTICLE III. NONPROFIT STATEMENT

Boardgames and Boba at UC San Diego is a non-profit student organization.

ARTICLE IV. REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP

There are no dues or fees required for membership. Every college student is eligible for membership. Membership is established through attending the event(s) and/or filling out a membership form. Being a member requires little to no commitment, but we may revoke membership if a member were to be disruptive and create an uncomfortable environment at events.

ARTICLE IV. SECTION 1. HAZING PREVENTION

Boardgames and Boba at UC San Diego is committed to maintaining a safe, inclusive, and respectful environment for all its members and does not condone hazing. Hazing, in any form, is strictly prohibited within the organization in compliance with state and federal law, Regents' policies and University regulations. Participation in hazing or any intentional, knowing, or reckless act, activity, or method committed by a person (whether individually or in concert with other persons) against another person or persons, including current, former, or prospective students, regardless of the willingness of such other person or persons to participate, that is committed in the course of a preinitiation, an initiation into, an affiliation with, or the maintenance of membership in, an official or unofficial student organization or other student group that i. causes or creates a risk, above the reasonable risk encountered in the course of participation in the institution of higher education or the organization (such as the physical preparation necessary for participation in an athletic team), of physical or

psychological injury, including personal degradation or disgrace, and/or ii. the person knew or should have known was likely to cause serious bodily injury. As an organization, we understand that failure to abide by hazing policies and laws will result in referral to the Center for Student Accountability, Growth, and Education (SAGE) for an organizational violation and/or individual violation(s).

ARTICLE V. MEETINGS

This organization aims to convene on a bi-monthly basis in the evening. Ultimately, meetings are dependent on the availability of officers to host the event and space availability of campus event spaces. Meetings are not mandatory to maintain membership, but we will still keep track of member attendance.

ARTICLE VI. QUALIFICATIONS FOR HOLDING OFFICE AND METHODS OF SELECTING AND REPLACING OFFICERS

Only registered UC San Diego students may hold office in the organization. Only registered UC San Diego students may vote in elections for the selection of the organization's officers. The current board of principal members that were registered by September 1, 2025 will make the final selection of new officers for the upcoming school year. Presuming an officer of the previous academic school year upheld their respective responsibilities, they may continue to work on the organization's board without going through the recruitment process again. If an officer did not fulfill responsibilities as expected during the previous academic school year, they may not continue to work on the organization's board without going through the recruitment process again. The recruitment process for new officers consists of an application and an interview. Recruitment shall occur as needed throughout the academic school year to ensure the smooth operations of the organization.

ARTICLE VI. SECTION 1. REMOVAL PROCESS

An officer is to be replaced or removed from their office position if their membership is to be revoked (as stated in Article IV) or is not fulfilling required responsibilities as expected (as determined by the principal members). The other officers will cast a vote, and the majority vote (51% or higher) will decide whether or not the officer will be replaced or removed from their office position. In the event of a tie, the president of Boardgames and Boba at UC San Diego will cast the deciding vote.

ARTICLE VII. RISK MANAGEMENT

Boardgames and Boba at UC San Diego is a registered student organization at the University of California, San Diego, but not part of the University itself. Boardgames and Boba at UC San Diego understands that the University does not assume legal liability for the actions of the organization. There is little to no risk to joining Boardgames and Boba at UC San Diego. As we will be offering boba tea drinks to members throughout the academic school year, the membership form will ask for any allergies or conditions, to which they will be accommodated to the best of the organization's ability.

ARTICLE VII. SECTION 1. IN CASE OF INTERACTION WITH MINORS AND/OR ELDERLY

Boardgames and Boba at UC San Diego will not work with minors or the elderly.

ARTICLE VII. SECTION 2. IN CASE OF THE PROVISION OF MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

Boardgames and Boba at UC San Diego will not be involved in providing any kind of medical assistance.

ARTICLE VII. SECTION 3. IN CASE OF INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

Boardgames and Boba at UC San Diego will not be engaged in any international travel.

ARTICLE VII. SECTION 4. IN CASE OF HANDLING OF HAZARDOUS CHEMICALS, MATERIAL, EQUIPMENT, AND/OR MACHINERY

Boardgames and Boba at UC San Diego will not handle any hazardous chemicals, materials, equipment, or machinery.

ARTICLE IX. COMMUNITY MENTOR

No community mentor is currently affiliated with the organization. But if the organization voted and decides to seek one, a mentor would be incorporated.

ARTICLE X. FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

Members are encouraged to bring in any games they already own to play with other members. In addition, the board will make efforts to secure funding from A.S. for the boba tea that is to be offered at events.
