

333 JUGGLERS AT UC SAN DIEGO CONSTITUTION - 2025-2026 ACADEMIC YEAR

ARTICLE I: NAME OF ORGANIZATION

The organization shall be called 333 Jugglers at UC San Diego.

ARTICLE II: STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

333 Jugglers at UC San Diego's main purpose is to create a safe social environment for learning and practicing juggling.

ARTICLE III: NONPROFIT STATEMENT

333 Jugglers at UC San Diego is a non-profit student organization.

ARTICLE IV: REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP

Section 4.1

333 Jugglers at UC San Diego is committed to maintaining a safe, inclusive, and respectful environment for all its members and does not condone hazing. Hazing, in any form, is strictly prohibited within the organization in compliance with state and federal law, Regents' policies and University regulations. Participation in hazing or any intentional, knowing, or reckless act, activity, or method committed by a person (whether individually or in concert with other persons) against another person or persons, including current, former, or prospective students, regardless of the willingness of such other person or persons to participate, that is committed in the course of a preinitiation, an initiation into, an affiliation with, or the maintenance of membership in, an official or unofficial student organization or other student group that i. causes or creates a risk, above the reasonable risk encountered in the course of participation in the institution of higher education or the organization (such as the physical preparation necessary for participation in an athletic team), of physical or psychological injury, including personal

degradation or disgrace, and/or ii. the person knew or should have known was likely to cause serious bodily injury. As an organization, we understand that failure to abide by hazing policies

and laws will result in referral to the Center for Student Accountability, Growth, and Education (SAGE) for an organizational violation and/or individual violations.

Section 4.2

Juggling meetings are open to all UC San Diego students, faculty, and staff. No dues or fees are required for membership. Donations are welcome and will go entirely towards providing juggling props.

ARTICLE V: FREQUENCY OF ORGANIZATION MEETINGS

333 Jugglers at UC San Diego will meet for a minimum of 3 hours per week, with the schedule decided before the start of each quarter.

ARTICLE VI: QUALIFICATIONS FOR HOLDING OFFICE AND METHODS OF SELECTING AND REPLACING OFFICERS

Only registered UC San Diego students may hold office in the organization. Only registered UC San Diego students may vote in elections for the selection of the organization's officers.

The president's role is to plan and organize juggling sessions and events, oversee organization activities, assign tasks to officers, and maintain a welcoming environment for incoming members.

The Social Media Manager is responsible for documenting meeting activities through photos and videos and maintaining the weekly newsletter and social media accounts of 333 Jugglers.

The Propsmaster/Treasurer is responsible for keeping track of and storing juggling props and any additional supplies. They will also be responsible for acquiring funding and managing funds for events and props.

Officers will be elected per quarter near the end of the previous quarter. All UC San Diego students who participate in meetings regularly will be eligible to apply. All new officers must be approved by a majority of the board to be accepted.

If an officer consistently fails to perform their tasks or violates the purpose of the club, they may be ejected with a majority vote from the board. Their duties will be shared among the board until the next election.

ARTICLE VII. RISK MANAGEMENT

333 Jugglers at UC San Diego is a registered student organization at the University of California, San Diego, but not part of the University itself.

333 Jugglers at UC San Diego understands that the University does not assume legal liability for the actions of the organization.

Juggling props thrown or used intentionally to hit may cause harm. Any member using juggling props in a malicious manner will be banned from the organization.

333Jugglers at UC San Diego is aware that all registered student organizations that serve minors or the elderly have access to training on child and elder abuse prevention for its members via UCLearning <https://uclearning.ucsd.edu> . 333Jugglers will develop plan(s) for activities and events where members will be interacting with minors or the elderly such that members will receive education and/or training on Child Abuse Neglect Reporting Act (CANRA), common sense measures to both avoid child or elder abuse allegations (i.e. avoiding one-on-one situations; working with minors in plain view of others; limiting calls/texts/social media posts or other communications with minors), and how to properly report potential harm or neglect to minors or the elderly with whom they are working.
