

## ConstiFOOSHion

The organization shall be called FOOSH. FOOSH is a non-profit student organization dedicated to teaching improvisational comedic techniques to the UC San Diego community of scholastic visionaries, and putting on free improv comedy shows at UCSD throughout the academic year. In order to join the club, prospective members are required to participate in one new member workshop put on at the beginning of Fall and Winter quarter. Members are recognized through a sign-in sheet that is distributed at the beginning of practice. Members are welcome to participate in both shows and practices, given they are a current student at UCSD. FOOSH meets twice weekly on Mondays and Wednesdays from 8-10 pm (subject to occasional changes).

To hold office one must be a UCSD student, maintain student status until the end of their term, and be elected by majority of the population of the club. There will be 1 president and 3 executive members at all times, elected at the end of spring quarter, serving until the end of the following academic year. In Fall Quarter of each academic year, a Freshman Executive officer will be elected by the FOOSH club population to serve for that academic year. To be eligible for this office, it must be the student's first year as a FOOSH member. Officers are responsible for casting all FOOSH shows. In the case that an officer is not performing their duties and is attending less than 70% of practices, they will be asked to step down by the remainder of the board, and an election will be held to elect a replacement.

FOOSH at UCSD is a registered student organization at University of California, San Diego, but not part of the University itself. FOOSH understands that the University does not assume legal liability for the actions of the organization. Possible risks associated

with our organization's activities include an incredibly minimal risk of physical injury; to prevent this, members are encouraged to minimize incidents of rambunctiousness.
