- I. The organization shall be called "PROSPECT Journal of International Affairs" at UCSD.
- II. PROSPECT Journal of International Affairs is an undergraduate journal of international/transnational affairs at the University of California, San Diego. Serving as a forum for intelligent discourse relating to international and transnational affairs, the journal showcases works created by undergraduates who wish to broaden their understanding of issues of contemporary and global relevance.
- III. PROSPECT Journal of International Affairs at UCSD is a non-profit student organization organization.
- IV. Prospective staff writers must submit two writing samples to Prospect for review by the Executive Team. They also must have a formal interview conducted by an Executive member of Prospect. Writers are hired based on the quality of the writing samples and the interview. Executive members of Prospect may be hired from within the staff or from outside of staff. Prospective Executive members must undergo an interview process. All members of the Prospect must be creative, hard-working, and possess an interest in international affairs. All members of Prospect must also be either undergraduate or graduate students at UCSD.
- V. PROSPECT Journal of International Affairs will have meetings once a week for staff and additional meetings for the executive team when necessary.
- VI. As stated above, officers will be selected through an interview process conducted by current Executive Members, which can vary depending on the position being sought. When a position is open, the entire staff will be notified and anyone in the staff is free to apply. Current Executive members will also seek out outside students to apply for the position. The current Executive Members will choose the candidate who exhibits the most potential and passion necessary for the position.
- VII. PROSPECT Journal of International Affairs at UCSD is a registered student organization at University of California, San Diego, but not part of the University itself.
