

Constitution for Muir Musical

Article I. Name of Student Organization:

The organization shall be called Muir Musical at UCSD.

Article II. Statement of Purpose:

The purpose of this organization is to produce an annual, student-run musical theater production.

Article III. Nonprofit Statement:

Muir Musical at UCSD is a non-profit student organization.

Article IV. Requirements for Membership:

- A. Undergraduates and graduate students from all six UCSD colleges are welcome to join. Only students will be considered for cast, orchestra, and production staff positions.
- B. Production staff positions are appointed positions chosen by the director. Cast and orchestra will be chosen after a fair and objective audition process. People not chosen to work on the production staff, orchestra, or cast will have the opportunity to help with the production in other capacities.
- C. There shall be no dues for participation. However, members may be asked to volunteer to help with fundraising for the production in some capacity.

Article V. Frequency of Organization Meetings:

The organization will meet as frequently as necessary, generally consisting of regular production staff meetings and orchestra rehearsals throughout one or two quarters. Generally, cast rehearsal will be held four to five nights a week during the quarter before the performance. This is followed by "tech week," where the final adjustments are made, and then two weeks of performances.

Article VI. Qualifications for Holding Office and Methods of Selecting and Replacing Officers:

The production staff for the show constitutes the officers of the organization. The production staff is constituted by the following positions:

- A. Director
- B. Stage Manager
- C. Managing Director
- D. Technical Director
- E. Marketing Director

F. Finance Director

The director shall be chosen by the organization advisors, Patricia Mahaffey and Steven Adler. Applications may be directed to them towards the end of the school year. They will interview candidates and choose the next year's director.

The director will appoint people to the positions within the production staff to the extent that they are able. Positions left unfilled should be advertised and applicants put through a fair and objective interview process. Any positions that are made vacant during the year may be filled at the discretion of the director.

Muir Musical at UCSD is a registered student organization at University of California, San Diego, but not part of the University itself.
